### **PAYMENT OPTIONS**

### 5. ITEMS FOR PERSONAL USE IN THE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The charge for **personal use items** will vary from student to student and includes:

- Requirements used in lessons e.g. stationery items, recorder, voluntary BYO school approved laptop Years 4-6.
- Pupil requirements recommended e.g. art shirt, tissues, hand sanitiser.
- Pupil requirements for selected students e.g. graduation T-shirt, class photograph.
- Other personal items e.g. school bags, lunch boxes, uniforms.

The recommended 'Personal Items Stationery List' notice for your child will be distributed early November 2022. All orders are to be made online. We have negotiated competitive prices for the materials on the list but you are not obliged to use our supplier. Your child will need to have listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items such as pencils throughout the year.
