



CHAPLAIN CONSENT FORM

Dear parents/caregivers

You may be aware that at Hawker Park we have a school Chaplain. The Chaplaincy Program has been running since 2011. The Chaplain is at the school 2 days a week, Thursdays and Fridays.

The role of the Chaplain at Hawker Park is to;

1. Support children and families who might be dealing with crisis, grief and loss in their lives.
2. Implement a program called "The Zones of Regulations". This is a curriculum designed to foster self-regulation and emotional control. The curriculum enables the children to improve their ability to recognise and communicate how they are feeling in a safe, non-judgemental way. It also allows children to tap into strategies or tools to help them move between Zones.

***Please note the role does not include religious instruction.**

The Chaplain is also able to see the children on a one-on-one basis if requested by the parent/caregiver or by the child or teacher. Below is a form which we ask to be completed each year which gives the Chaplain permission to work with your child one-on-one.
