As part of our annual celebrations, we'll be holding our much-loved Book Swap again this term!

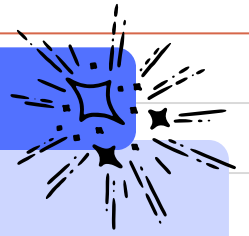
Please bring in any pre-loved children's books in good condition to donate.

Only students that donate books will participate in the book swap.



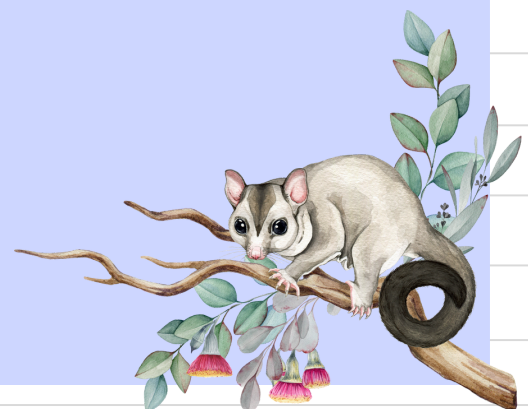

CCTV Installation for School Safety

Last week, six CCTV cameras were installed at key locations around the school to help monitor all main entry points. New signage has also been placed to let our community know the premises are under video surveillance.

Thanks to a government grant, this initiative is in place to help keep our school safe by discouraging after-hours damage and antisocial behaviour. Footage is viewed only by school administration, and if an incident occurs outside school hours, the police may request access to assist with their investigations.

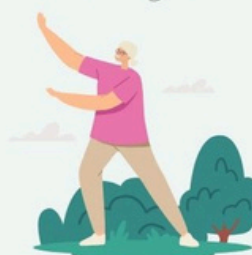
