- Long hair must be tied back

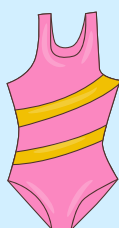
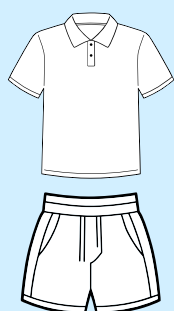
Children can come to school with their bathers worn under their uniform to go to the pool. Towel will be taken to the pool in a named bag.

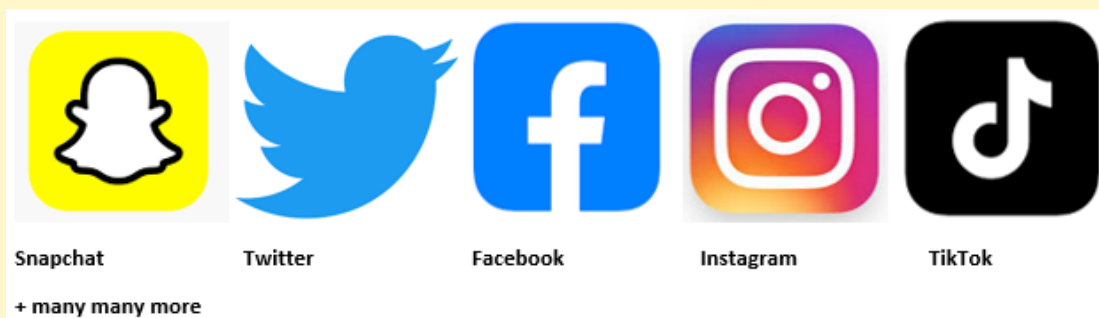


Social media age restrictions
