### DID YOU KNOW?

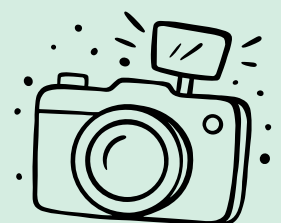
- For important dates for 2026 including swimming lessons and faction/interschool carnivals, please scroll down


