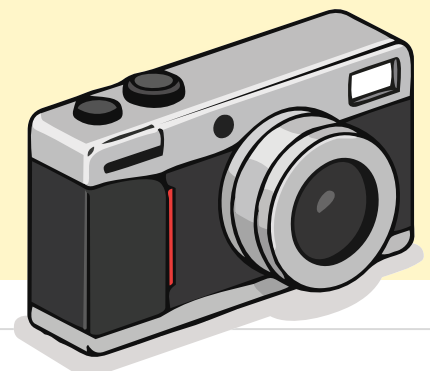
New members are welcome and there are many ways to assist the P&C without needing to attend meetings.
