SCHOOL PROCESSES

SCHOOL PROCESSES - External Providers

External Providers: If a parent wishes for an external professional e.g. OT, Speech Therapist etc, paid for by the parent, to work with the child while at school, the process is as follows.

1. Parent needs School permission. This is ONLY given after Principal consultation with the Class Teacher (CT).
2. Once CT gives approval, then parent and providers complete documentation available from the front office.
3. Completed Documentation is returned to the front office and kept by the Principal.
4. The external professional negotiates with the CT regarding time out of class for the child.
5. While on school premises the external provider is accountable to the Principal.

Generally speaking, it is preferable for external providers to work with children outside of the school, but this is dependent on a discussion between the parent and the Principal.

Enrolment Requirements

When enrolling your child, you will be asked to provide:

- Student's Birth Certificate or Passport
- If your child is an Australian citizen but both parents were born overseas, then proof of one of the parent's permanent residency/citizenship
- Australian Immunisation History (AIR) Statement (dated within 2 months).
- Visa documents (if applicable)

Proof of Address Documents can include:

- A Lease Agreement, Proof of ownership of a property such as Land / Water Rates Notice, Driver's License or a recent gas or electrical account

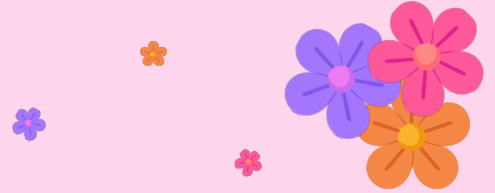
Additional Needs / Medical Diagnosis:

- Parents/carers of students with additional needs are asked to contact the school, to discuss their child's requirements.

CANTEEN GRANT

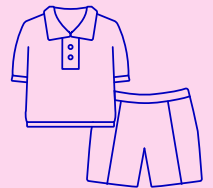


The WA Government opened a competitive grant for canteen upgrades, for which the P&C and the School put in an application. This was spearheaded by Cassy, who worked around the clock to make it happen.

One of the requirements for the grant application was to assess the canteen menu – the government uses a 'foodchecker' system to assess if menu items are red, amber, or green, in terms of their health rating.

YEAR 6 CAMP

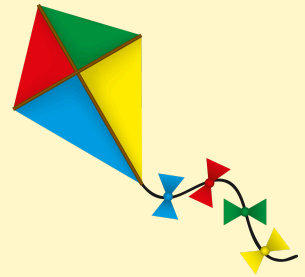
Our Year 6 students had an absolutely fantastic time at camp!

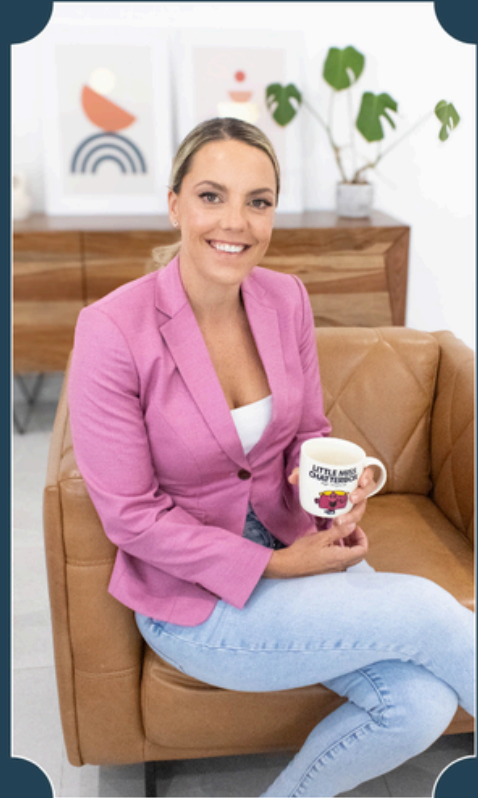

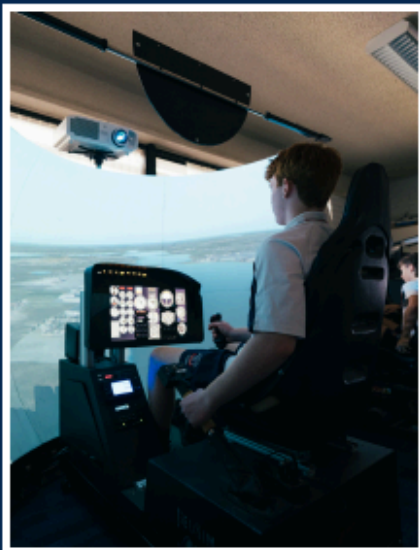
