## SCHOOL PROCESSES - CLASS REWARDS

As part of our positive behaviour and reward systems, each classroom teacher selects rewards that best suit their class. While some classes have chosen a Pyjama Day as a reward, other classes have selected different reward activities.

Please note that students should only wear pyjamas to school when their **classroom teacher has specifically advised them to do so**. If no communication has been sent home from your child's teacher, students are expected to wear their regular school uniform.

### **Enrolment Requirements**

When enrolling your child, you will be asked to provide:

- Student's Birth Certificate or Passport
- If your child is an Australian citizen but both parents were born overseas, then proof of one of the parent's permanent residency/citizenship
- Australian Immunisation History (AIR) Statement (dated within 2 months).
- Visa documents (if applicable)
- Kindergarten & Pre-primary history form

### **Proof of Address Documents can include:**

- A Lease Agreement, Proof of ownership of a property such as Land / Water Rates Notice, Driver's License or a recent gas or electrical account

### **Additional Needs / Medical Diagnosis:**

- Parents/carers of students with additional needs are asked to contact the school, to discuss their child's requirements.

# A NOTE FROM THE P&C

### **P&C Parliament visit**

Our P&C president, Mariana Hopper, attended a Parliament visit and meeting with Jessica Stojkovski MLA and the Western Australian Minister for Education Sabine Winton. The event was attended by multiple P&Cs in our electorate and was incredibly informative and a valuable opportunity to network with other P&Cs. It was great to receive recognition for all the work that the different P&Cs undertake and the value that we deliver to the students, schools, and communities. Certainly something to be proud of!

### **And what does the P&C do?**

So far in 2026, our P&C has provided the following to our children and families:

- Face painting at the 2026 welcome picnic.
- Canteen service twice a week, with generally over 100 orders per day the canteen runs.
- New canteen freezer to make the operations run more smoothly.
- Secondhand uniform sales, once in Term 1 and once in Term 2. We sold a total of 123 items so far this year, ensuring that the clothes stay out of landfill for as long as possible, that we have affordable options, and the funds go to a collective cause.
- Fundraising through everlasting seeds sales, which was a resounding success!
- Mother's Day stall. This one is both a fundraiser and an opportunity to enrich the children's engagement and autonomy. It was fantastic to see the little hands browsing the gifts and the opportunity for them to exercise their decision-making and maths skills.
- Organising a raffle for the Dunsborough weekend getaway.
- Scholastic book sales. This is being run once per term, and apart from allowing parents to order books which are delivered to the children, Scholastic directs part of the sales proceedings to our school library, ensuring we can build on our stock.
- Locked in the DJ for our neon Disco, later in the year.
- Raise funds through the Containers for Change system. Containers sold at the canteen are dropped off for recycling and the funds raised also contribute to the fundraising efforts.
- Engage with parents and the school staff to understand what is needed, what is wanted, and provide support where possible.
- Provide opportunities for parents and community members to volunteer and engage with one another, creating stronger community bonds.

# AUS ALERT



AusAlert will be ready to use in October 2026, but before it launches, the system needs to be tested across Australia.

## About the test

On Monday 27 July 2026, a test alert will be sent to all mobile devices in Australia.

This includes most phones, and some smart watches and tablets.

## Time of national test

The test alert will be sent at the same time on Monday 27 July.

### Western Australia (WA)

12:00 pm (AWST – UTC+8:00)

## What to expect

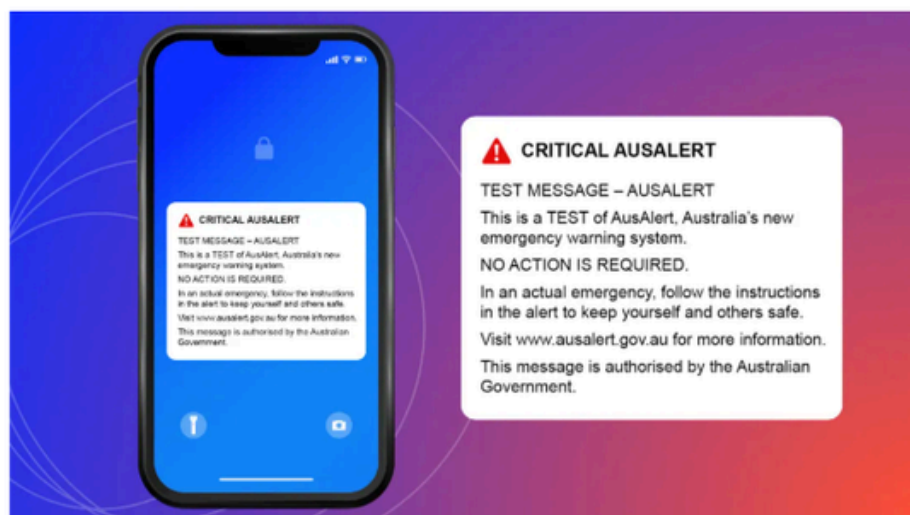
At the time of the test, a single [Critical AusAlert](#) test will be sent to every mobile device in Australia. Everyone with a compatible phone or other device in Australia can expect to receive the alert.

Devices will vibrate and play a siren-like warning sound for about 10 seconds.

An AusAlert message will appear on device screens. It will clearly say it is a test.

Exactly how it appears will depend on your device type and operating system.

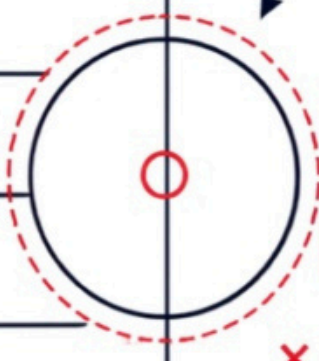
